**Risk Assessment for Bubble Machine/Snow ( foam) Machine and Bubble Show ( Indoors and Outdoors**

Hazard	People at risk	Action taken
Skin irritation	Mostly younger children	Tell people that they are playing with detergent and washing up liquid which is safe but can cause irritation. Advise people to rinse their hands in cold water when they have finished making bubbles
Eyes stinging and irritation	Mostly children	. Tell children not to put their fingers in their eyes. Advise people to rinse their hands in cold water when they have finished making bubbles
Falling on slippery surface	Staff and public	Bubbles are best suited to a grass surface. Organisers must provide a safe, non-potentially-slippery place for this activity.
Poking in the face with a bubble wand or hit with plastic ring on the end of the ribbon	Smaller children	Do not allow misbehaviour. Tell children not to swing bubble wands around. Avoid overcrowding
Electrocution	Staff and public	Bubble making is a very wet activity with lots of water – be aware of electrical hazard

Please note : the bubble/snow/foam entertainment area due to the fact of using bubble/foam solution can / will get slippery and as a condition of booking it is accepted and acknowledged that it is the responsibility of the bookie to make all aware of this slip hazard and ask for the entertain to stop if they attain it is becoming a risk.
